Programme overview May 14-26

Sunday **May I4th** students arrive at the Santalahti resort, where they will be accommodated. The same day from I7:00 we will join for fun, talks, snacks and a little info. The programme formally kicks off Monday May I5th 9am at the venue: Datariina, Heikinkatu 7, 48100 Kotka, Finland.

First week

Focus is on how to proceed from an open idea for a new solution concept, to sketching various concepts – and to start designing a strong solution. You center your work around "personas and user insights", "value proposition design", "business model creation" and "Lean StartUP" methods.

Second week

You focus on selecting the best conceptual ideas, bringing them to live as a concept, codevelop this with a specific company and finalize your work and pitch it for a board of specialists. Here you test your concept's attractiveness, feasibility and viability - **and get valuable feedback from professionals and peers.**

The programme is full of interesting master classes, workshops and practical learning from workshops and co-meetings in our partner companies. The programme also includes a range of fun social activities like participating in a recruitment fair, a trail running competition, dinners with local staff from partnering companies and social fun within and across student teams.
